"Disciple-Making Disciples" – Matthew 28: 16–20 (Pastor Allison Alvares)

Matthew 28:16 -20 known as the great commission outlines the importance of making disciples. Jesus has given us a grand invitation. He has called us to be more than just Christians by name but true followers of Christ. We are encouraged to reflect on Jesus as our master and owner, as highlighted in 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. As we apprentice under Jesus, we learn that making disciples is essential, not optional. Bearing witness requires us to know Jesus intimately and act according to the Holy Spirit's guidance in our daily lives. The Spirit gives us all we need to be witnesses for Jesus. We should be actively involved in disciple making, both as being discipled and making disciples. We must consider, what or who is discipling us and who we are discipling.
