Part 1: Repentance, Restoration & Revival

Our Heavenly Father,

Part 4: Missions

Dear Lord Jesus,

We pray specifically for our international workers, who have left their homes and families to serve You in distant lands. We ask for Your protection over them, that You would shield them from harm and provide for their every need. Grant them favor with the local authorities and communities, that they might build strong relationships and have opportunities to share the gospel in meaningful ways. Lord, we ask that You would give them a deep sense of Your presence, especially in moments of loneliness and discouragement. Part 5: Unsaved Loved Ones

Our Heavenly Father,

Part 6: Healing & Wholeness

Dear Lord Jesus,

We ask that You would bring reconciliation where there has been division, peace where there has been strife, and love where there has been hatred. Heal broken relationships,

restore trust, and bring unity among us. Let Your love bind us together in perfect harmony, and may we reflect Your grace and mercy in all our interactions.

We declare Your promise in Jeremiah 30:17, "But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds," over every area of brokenness in our lives—physical, emotional, mental, and relational. We trust in Your faithfulness to complete the good work You have begun in us. Father, we ask for Your healing touch to bring wholeness and restoration, that we may walk in the fullness of life that You have promised. 
